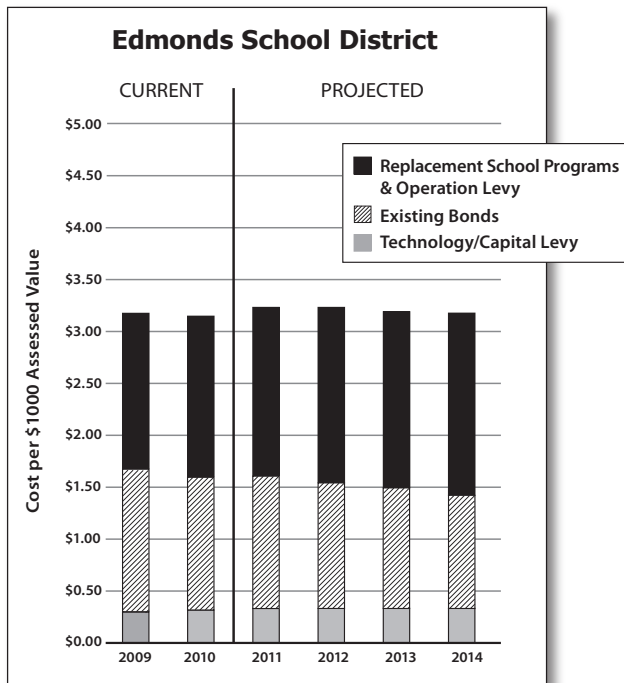

Replacement Levy Facts:

- This is not a new tax;
- This replaces an existing levy that is expiring;
- This replacement levy directly funds classroom and support programs;
- This replacement levy represents 20 cents of every dollar spent to provide and support student learning;
- This is an all mail-in election. Ballots for this election measure will arrive to households during the latter part of the week of January 19, 2010.
