## Small Ensemble Electives

Each student will select a focus Ensemble Elective (Jazz Band, Jazz Choir, Instrumental Ensemble) for his or her daily schedule. These groups offer learning and performance opportunities in a small ensemble context.



## Exploratory Electives

Exploratory Electives are designed as fun and interesting opportunities to try something new. Here are some classes that have been offered in the past; Beginning Instruments, Electronic Music, Composition & Arranging, Small Ensembles, Music Theory, Steel Drums, Vocal Techniques, Xylophone Ensemble, Guitar, and group piano lessons. Electives will be offered depending on student interest, equipment and staffing availability.

## March in a Parade

All students will have the opportunity to march in the Edmonds 4<sup>th</sup> of July Parade. This has been a great addition to our SMS program. Students will learn a marching band song, or learn to do a flag routine. It is a wonderful and fun event for the whole family.



## Exciting Field Trips
