

# Purchasing School Meals 2008-09

## Ways to Pay

- Cash
- Check (made payable to “Edmonds School District”)
- Free- and/or reduced-price meals eligibility (applications available)
- Washington Basic Food Program – new eligibility requirements Oct. 1.



Advantages to this system include:

- Email alerts for low and negative balances.
- Information on what items are purchased.

Student ID number needed to create an account for each student.

## Starting October 1, 2008:

**When a child does not have money for that day’s meal ...**

### Grades Kindergarten through 6

- A maximum debt/negative balance of \$15 is allowed per student.
- After that, a student either brings cash or check for each day’s food purchases or receives a “safety net” meal (described below).

### Grades 7 through 12

- A maximum debt/negative balance of \$15 is allowed per student.
- Student receives a maximum of 2 “safety net” meals; if the account balance is still negative, a student can either bring cash or check for each day’s food purchases or buy a “safety net” meal for \$1 (described below).

### Ways to verify your child’s balance

- Ask the cashier at your child’s school

#### *Does Your Child Know?*

If a student goes back for seconds or selects additional items (a la carte), an additional charge is put on your child’s account. Please discuss this with your child.
