Each year the Board of Directors selects at least one student advisor from each high school according to Board Policy #1265.

For example, one student could serve as advisor for the first half of the year and the other would serve the second half. The School Board does reserve the right to select a single student as advisor for the entire school year. The School Board may conduct interviews of the applicants.

Responsibilities of the student advisor include serving as a liaison between the Board of Directors and Student Body, attending School Board meetings as a non-voting member (two Tuesdays a month) and providing input, and reporting on student activities occurring at their high school.
