A contract between the Edmonds School District and King County will be executed as authorized by law through Board action at public board meetings.


BACKGROUND:


This Interlocal Cooperative Agreement will allow the District to participate in competitive bids offered by King County. The District will have the opportunity to participate in established contracts issued by King County if those contracts are in the District's best interest. It creates an efficient method of meeting the district's competitive bidding requirements.

RATIONALE:


RCW 28A.320 and RCW 39.34, the Interlocal Cooperative Act, permit the District to establish interlocal cooperative purchasing agreements with other Political Subdivisions. This will allow participating Political Subdivisions to take advantage of competitive bids completed by either of the parties.

AUTHORIZE COOPERATIVE PURCHASING AGREEMENT
for the purpose of purchasing goods and services procured by
King County, Washington through the competitive bid process

WHEREAS, RCW 28A.320 and RCW 39.34, the Interlocal Cooperative Act, permits the District to establish interlocal cooperative purchasing agreements with other Political Subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, Edmonds School District No. 15 and any King County desire to reduce their respective costs in purchasing various equipment, supplies and services; and


WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of each of the parties has determined that the best interest of each district shall be served by the formation and maintenance of a joint purchasing agreement;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Edmonds School District No. 15, Snohomish County, as follows:


1. That a joint purchasing cooperative by and between Edmonds School District No. 15, and King County hereinafter referred to as "the parties" be formed as an interlocal cooperative for the purpose of purchasing various equipment, supplies and services.
2. That the Superintendent or designee of Edmonds School District No. 15, Snohomish County, Washington, is hereby designated as representative to the joint purchasing cooperative, and the Superintendent or designee is further authorized to execute and implement the requisite agreement or agreements to accomplish this purpose.
3. That the Edmonds School District No. 15 reserves the right to contract independently for the purpose of any items or services, with or without notice to the districts.

In accordance with Chapter 39.34 RCW, King County and the Edmonds School District No. 15 agree to a cooperative governmental purchasing agreement for various equipment and supplies using King County's competitively awarded contracts.

King County therefore extends the use of its contracts to the Edmonds School District No. 15 to the extent provided by law and upon the following terms:

- (1) The vendor(s) agree to extend to the Edmonds School District No. 15 the terms and conditions of King County's contract(s).
- (2) Edmonds School District No. 15 accepts responsibility for compliance with any additional or varying laws and regulations governing its purchases. Any purchases by the Edmonds School District No. 15 shall be effected by a purchase order from the Edmonds School District No. 15 and directed to the vendor.
- (3) King County accepts no responsibility for the performance of any of the purchasing contracts by the vendor.
- (4) King County accepts no responsibility for payment of the purchase price by the Edmonds School District No. 15.

This agreement may be revoked at any time in writing by either party.
