




State Assessments

Academic Accomplishments and Goals – Focus Areas


For this school year, we are focused on improving student success in mathematics, and in increasing partnerships with the wonderful families in our community. This is our Theory of Action:

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3. Increasing math outcomes for all of our students, especially those with special needs and English Language Learners.


