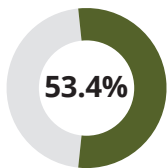

Our 522 students at a glance:

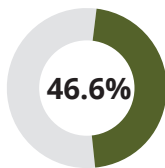


State Assessments

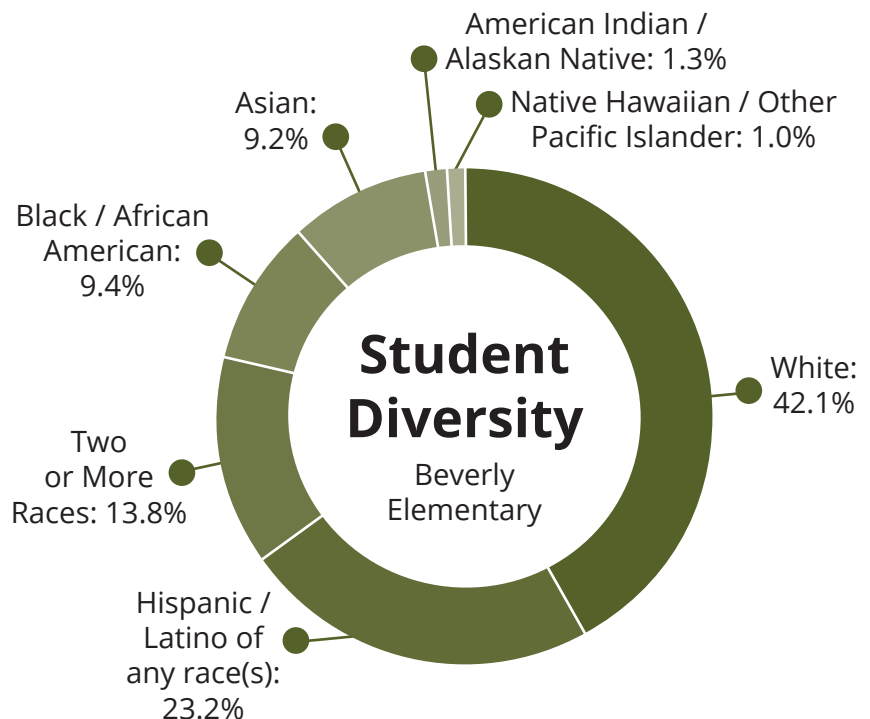

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English learners' abilities and needs as readers using the achievement level descriptors.

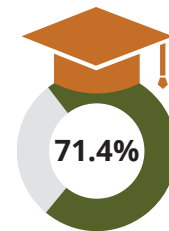
- Using the assessment data and the achievement level descriptors to differentiate instruction.
