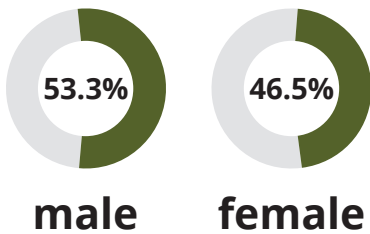

Washington students are tested annually by the state to assess their progress as they move through school. In grades 3-8 students take tests in English language arts, math and science. Please see [our School Report Card](#).



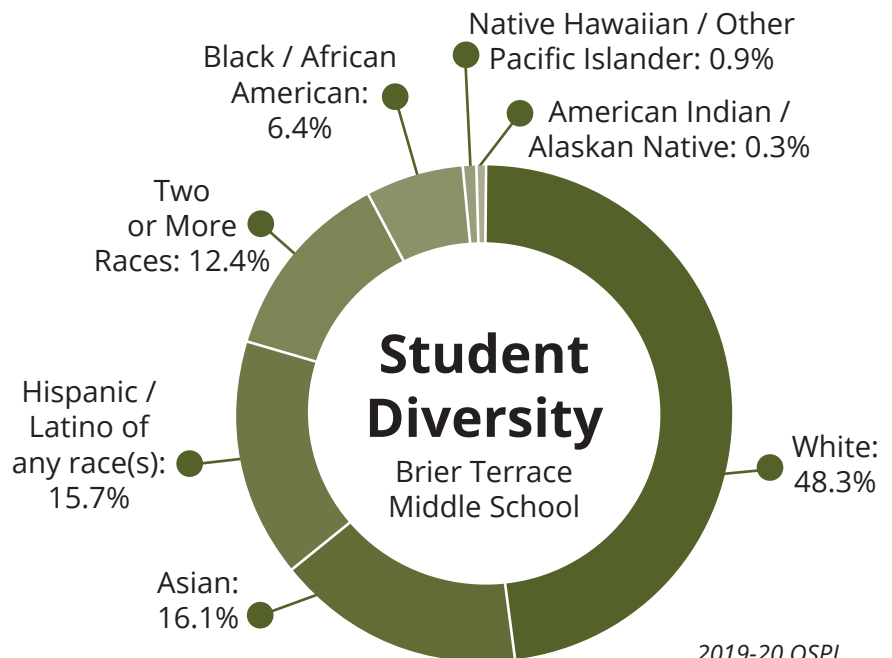

Academic Accomplishments and Goals – Focus Areas

For 2020-21 our staff will engage in learning centered on building positive relationships with students. This will draw from our previous work from resources focused on Equity, Restorative Practices, and Social and Emotional Learning. Given that the year is starting in the Continuous Learning 2.0 model, we are particularly focusing this on how to connect with students in these circumstances. We will use both staff and student survey data as well as student learning data to assess and guide our work throughout the year. Some of the things we will be working on together are:

- Survey students Monthly using Social and Emotional Learning tool called Panorama
- Create a Social and Emotional Learning Team to analyze the data and create and guide the Professional Learning for the year

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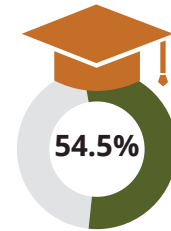
- Gather student Engagement and Attendance Data from teachers to identify students who are not attending and/or not engaging in learning activities
- Create a an Engagement and Attendance Team to guide and implement interventions for students
- Focus our Equity Team on student engagement and student voice
- Begin Leadership and Journalism classes in order to heighten student voice in the school community
- Develop specific targeted intervention/enrichment to support student growth
- All of this with the goal of improving student learning
