## Mission Statement of School and District

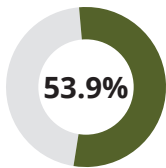

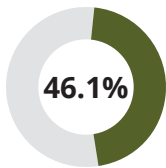


### State Assessments

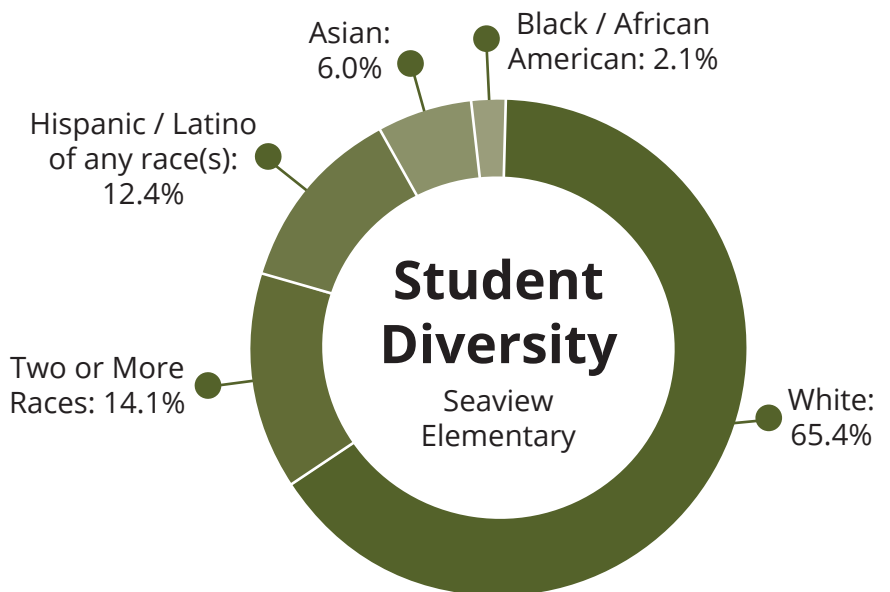

### Academic Accomplishments and Goals – Focus Areas

In 2020-21, our growth goal will be to increase student academic growth using Tiered interventions in all content areas with a focus on Reading. Teachers will collaborate in professional learning communities to continue to study and gain knowledge of effective instructional strategies for all students (Tier 1, 2, 3), and will implement new strategies in their classrooms, resulting in student growth in all areas. Focusing on Reading, we will use ESD assessments and tracking, measuring progress aligned with State and district standards.

We believe that classrooms filled with Tiered Instructional Strategies will result in academic growth in Reading, Writing and Speaking achievement for all students.

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**As a result of this work we expect that:**

Due to COVID-19 we do not have the State Testing data from 2019-20. We will use ESD adopted assessments that are State Standard Based to measure student achievement. We believe that all students will make Reading growth in 2020-2021.

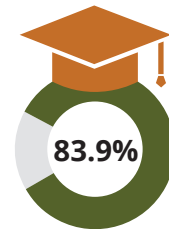
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**How You Can Help**
