In 2016-17 teachers will strive to intentionally foster relationships with students and design rigorous, relevant, accessible standards-based tasks. As a result of this work:

- Teachers will regularly and collaboratively analyze data/evidence of student learning from tasks, and then modify and differentiate their instruction for all students and small groups.
- Teachers will give timely feedback to students (and families) relative to student progress on meeting the standards.
- Students will make informed choices and have more ownership over their learning and achievement and use technology and digital media strategically and capably.
- Student academic performance will increase and academic achievement gaps will decrease.

As a result of this work our school wide goal is:

Compared to 64 percent of students in 2015-16, 74 percent of students will agree or strongly agree with the statement, "I sometimes get to choose what type of work I

do in my classes" on the Student Opinion Survey in 2016-17. Compared to 87 percent of students in 2015-16, 92 percent of students will agree or strongly agree with the statement, "I know when I do things correctly in my classes" on the 2016-17 Student Opinion Survey.

Additionally, individual student goals for improvement on state testing have been established.
