

Procedures Joint Use of Operating Facilities

The superintendent or designee may approve joint use of facilities for up to one (1) year. Joint use shall be consistent with the district's mission and practices. Joint use agreements for longer than one (1) year may require approval by the board.

All joint use agreements executed pursuant to the above shall include provisions which permit the recapture of the joint use space on fair terms should such property be needed for school purposes.

RCW 28A.335.040

Joint Use Priorities

1. Uses which enhance the educational program, such as:
 - Day-care center
 - Preschool
 - Special education services required by law and not provided by the district
 - Visual, musical, live theater artists – recreational activities if they provide direct services to students
 - Library services
 - Human services delivery agencies (e.g., health services, counseling)

Process for Offering Property for Joint Use

The superintendent or designee may consider proposals for the joint use of space from other governmental entities, public or private federally recognized nonprofit organizations.

After deliberating with district stakeholders, the superintendent or designee may approve individual proposals based on the best interests of the district.
