Scholarship Program History

The Randy Terlicker Memorial Aquatics and Life Safety Scholarship program was established by the City of Lynnwood in 1995. The scholarship is awarded to those desiring to improve themselves and their community through education and training in aquatics, life safety, and related areas of study.

Randy Terlicker was the Lynnwood Aquatics Supervisor from 1988 to 1990. In 1990, he became a Seattle Firefighter while continuing to teach Water Safety Instructor, CPR, and First Aid classes at the Recreation Center. Randy lost his life in the line-of-duty as a firefighter on January 5, 1995. This scholarship was established to commemorate Randy's dedication to safety and his high standards of excellence.

Randy's character was genuine. He was boisterous and animated. Known as the "Gentle Giant," he was a sensitive, soft and noble man. Randy will always be known as "more than a man, a mountain of a man." Through his example, may others be inspired.

The scholarship program dedication was held October 1, 1995 at the Lynnwood Recreation Center. The bronze plaque, located in the pool natatorium, was unveiled. A Mountain Blue Spruce tree, donated by the Berube family, was planted at the entrance to the Recreation Center. The Terlicker family donated the bronze plaque at the base of the tree.

Scholarship Guidelines

The Randy Terlicker Memorial Scholarship is a financial assistance program funded by private donations. The RTMS Fund will provide twelve individual scholarships for lifeguard training courses at the Lynnwood Recreation Center in 2015.

Applicants for this scholarship must be:

- Between the ages of 15 - 20 years old
- Live within the Edmonds School District boundary
- Have an qualified income level (see income chart) or be a recipient of the Free Lunch Program through the Edmonds School District.
- Meet the swimming qualification for lifeguard training.

Participants who qualify will receive a 100% discount on registration fees for lifeguard training at the Lynnwood Recreation Center. A \$35 certificate fee is due to American Red Cross to access online materials. Instructions for online access will be sent to email provided at time of registration. Scholarship awards do not guarantee placement in a class; registration is on a first-come, first-served basis.

To apply, complete the application form and submit it with a letter of interest describing why you are applying for this scholarship and how - if you are awarded a scholarship - you will fulfill Randy's legacy.

Be sure to attach the required documentation to determine your eligibility. All applications must be submitted in advance of class start date.

Applications will be approved at the time of submittal depending on staff availability. All approvals are contingent upon available funds.

Information is reviewed and verified by the fund staff only; all information is kept confidential.
