Outside is the story of Daniel, a teen who triumphs over homophobic bullying. During a meeting of the Gay Straight Alliance (GSA) at his new school, Daniel shares his story. Meanwhile at his old school, Daniel's friends attempt to start their own GSA. Using flashbacks, we travel through Daniel's harrowing experience that began with a taunt and a text message, and eventually led to a serious physical assault.
