Meadowdale Basketball Season Details

Season:

All practices and performances are available through the TeamSnap app or at TeamSnap.com. Practices are at Meadowdale Middle School, Monday & Wednesday from 6:00-7:30 pm. Games are typically on Saturdays. The NSJC Winter Competition date is March 21st. Cheerleaders should plan on missing no more than 5 practices and/or performances throughout the season. The season runs from mid November to mid March.

Roles:

Carrie Anderson, NSJC President: Carrie handles the behind the scenes administrative duties required to run the organization. She is not a coach but supervises some games. Paperwork, payment questions, and large issues should go through her. Many last minute changes or organization communications will come through TeamSnap from Carrie.

Kayla McArthur, Cheer Director: Kayla is the main parent and participant contact for the organization. She attends practices to supervise and train the coaches, and to be available for questions and concerns.

Head & Assistant Coaches (varies per season): This is your participants main point of contact. They will be coaching your cheerleader, advancing their skills and helping them build confidence in the sport. If you are unable to resolve an issue with your athletes head coach, please see Kayla. If the head coach cannot be available for practice, practice may be cancelled or ran by the assistant coach.

Squads:

Junior Squad:

- 1st to 3rd Graders
- Typically cheers for afternoon games
- Performs cheer & routine at Competition
- Learns prep level stunts and below

Senior Squad:

- 4th to 8th Grade
- Typically cheers for evening games
- Performs cheer & routine at Competition
- Learns up to extension level stunts

Registration Fees:

\$290: Tuition (Due November 12th). This includes costs associated with the organization including tuition, fees, association dues, rental space, competitions fees, rental uniforms, etc.

\$185: Spirit Pack (Due December 12th). Cheer bag, poms, spanx, bodysuit, cheer shoes, and bow.

Discounted spirit pack pricing is available for returning cheerleaders.

Return Policy:

Due to the high cost and custom fitting of uniforms, no refunds will be issued after the orders for uniforms are placed (immediately following the fitting), and both Tuition and Spirit Pack fees will be billed if not yet paid, even if you cheerleader no longer attends practice and/or performances.

Scholarships:

\$50-\$100 Scholarships are available toward the fees each season to students and families who qualify for free or reduced lunch and who cannot pay for the full registration fee. \$100 scholarship and available for the athlete's first season, and \$50 scholarships are available for each subsequent season. If you are in need of a scholarship, select YES for Free/Reduced Lunch and attach your child's award letter from the school showing approval of free/reduced lunch.

I understand my child will not be able to practice until the Tuition payment is made and gear will not be distributed unless the Spirit Pack payment is made (including any additional swag items).
