Free Summer Math and Lunch Program

Weekdays M-Th Starting July 7th – August 14th

Math Sessions: 9 – 11 a.m. & 12 - 2 p.m.

Free Lunch 11 a.m. – 12 p.m.

The Summer Math Tutoring Program is a student-centered, self-paced approach to mathematics that dramatically improves math proficiency in students willing to invest some time each day over the summer. Summer Math is for students who need math support in Grades 4-10. Use of computer-based Khan Academy and/or Xtramath enables students to quickly and sequentially review topics they understand, slowing only to learn and master concepts that are not fully understood. Each day begins with a short review of topics previously mastered and then moves on to the point where the student previously left off.

Paid Site Supervisors: Report to the Program Administrator and are responsible for making sure the site is used only as intended, that students remain in areas designated for use by the summer math and lunch program and that students and volunteers follow program guidelines and rules. They communicate with the volunteers to make sure that each site has full staffing each day. They also help tutor students in mathematics.

Math Volunteers: Open to high school and college students, parents, as well as members of the community to support students with basic arithmetic through algebra concepts.

Lunch Volunteers: Supervise lunchtime in the cafeteria to make sure students and families are cleaning up after themselves, work on math flash cards with students, encourage reading, etc.
