

## Northwest's Child: After School and Summer Care for Children with moderate to severe special needs.

**N**orthwest's Child is a non-profit, after school, extended learning program for school aged children and youth with moderate to severe developmental, physical and/or multiple disabilities. Our students range in age from 5 to 21 yrs.

Northwest's Child is located in Edmonds Elementary and serves from all corners of the local school districts including Edmonds, Northshore, Everett and Mukilteo. Students enrolled in Northshore, Mukilteo and Everett can be transported via DART bus door to door to our program after school. DART is also commonly used by many of our families to transport our student's home at the end of the day each day. We monitor these services very closely so that the needs & safety of each student is priority.

Our students, many of whom have challenges such as Cerebral Palsy, Downs Syndrome or Autism, work with our head teachers & assistants each day on a variety of skill areas. Some of the main areas we focus on are, vocational training, independent living, social/emotional skills and community integration. We work closely with each student's IEP as well as their school teachers and parents in order to provide the best individual & group based programs for all.



Our program runs 12 months a year, 5 days a week. We operate a full day summer program as well as full days on "school out" days throughout the school year.

Northwest's Child is a licensed agency & contracted with DSHS in order to access many forms of funding that is paid on a monthly basis.
