



STEP 3: Math

Select Math by finding where you are...and moving on to the next course. Full-IB students must get to a yellow box by Senior year

You eventually **must** get to **any one** of the bold boxes to get to an IB exam.

Using words:

If you are currently in Math 8, you choose Algebra.

If you are currently in Algebra 1, you choose Geometry.

We do not offer Geometry Honors. No, I don't know why

If you are currently in Geometry, you choose Algebra 2

Honors.

If you are currently in **Algebra 2 Honors**, you choose **Pre-Calculus for IB.**

For music kids, most of the boxes are now full.

But we aren't done.

Because now every student – including Music students – need to rank several choices, because every student takes several electives in the Freshman year.

Step 4: Picking Some Electives



Now, whether you are in Music or not, the issue of choosing electives is one of preference and priorities.

You select a series of electives, and we do our very best to give you the ones that you have prioritized.

For Honors, Electives Always Start With Art....

Many colleges require students take one year of Art classes to apply.

We encourage you to take art classes in the Freshman year because – for IB students in particular – we can't guarantee you are going to have time to take ART later. Some things to note:

- Music counts as Art (so you music kids have met this requirement)!
- Drama counts as Art (great for students developing their public speaking skills

- You are not required to be in ONE Art class all year.
- Two semester Art classes = one year of Art college requirement

After that, all of these physical art courses are open to you:

- Clay Design 1/2/3
- Glass Experience
- Mixed Media Art

You talked a lot about honors. Do we need to take a full honors load?

We want you to be successful, both in high school and beyond. This is a presentation for students pursuing full-IB, so I'm doing my part to prep you to take IB classes and be ready for honors programs.

I was told that if I took the district language test, I'd have credit in high school. Sorry. You have to be enrolled in a second language to meet IB requirements; the district "test for language credit" doesn't mean anything to the IB – and since we aren't using the district credit chart to graduate, those credits aren't necessary. You must start with French, Mandarin, or Spanish.

Just checking: Music classes count as Art for the purposes of my future college application plans, right? Yep. Music is Art. Always has been. Always will be.

What's your best piece of advice for parents? It sounds silly, but please make sure your email address and contact information is legible when you register at EWHS. If there are issues, we need to contact you and, sometimes, your info is illegible.

Do I have to take Art classes as a freshman?

No, but later on, if you decide to apply to a college that requires a year of Art, you might not have any room in your schedule to take it. We learned this lesson the hard way many years ago, and this is the best advice we can give for you to keep ALL of your college options open.

We don't want you to discover – three years from now – that you have to do a year of art and have absolutely no room in your schedule to do it.
