In-person opportunities are expanding ...

Here is a timeline of students returning to our schools since the COVID-19 pandemic began.

The district is following all state and county health guidelines in order to offer in-person opportunities for our students in the safest ways possible.

November 2020

- ► Deaf & Hard of Hearing program (preschool-6th grade)
- ► Visually Impaired program (preschool-6th grade)
- ► E-Hub (serving students of all ages experiencing unstable housing)

December 2020

► Continued with the same in-person programs launched in November

January 2021

- ► Developmental Kindergarten
- ► Some Special Education programs

February 2021

- ► Secondary students identified as English Learners
- ► Outdoor athletic conditioning pods (9th-12th grade)
- ► High school fall sports

March 2021

- ► 2nd/1st grade
- ➤ 7th-12th grade:
 - Those identified as needing additional support
 - Enrichment opportunities in the afternoon
- ► Additional Special Education programs (Kindergarten-6th grade)

April 2021

- ► Kindergarten
- ► Some Developmental Preschool programs
- ► Early Childhood Education and Assistance Program (ECEAP)
